AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT

Programs and Services:

The State of Utah complies with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) by providing qualified individuals with disabilities services, programs, and activities the State offers.

Employment:

The State of Utah complies with the ADA by providing employment opportunities to qualified individuals with disabilities.

Prohibitions:

The ADA makes it unlawful to discriminate against a qualified individual with a disability. The ADA also provides that no qualified individual with a disability shall, by reason of such disability, be excluded from participation in or be subjected to discrimination by any such entity.
